

Scholarships

"Congar School for Ecumenics" of the Institute for Ecumenical Studies of the Angelicum

General Information

- The "Congar School for Ecumenics" is a Postdoctoral Research Programme for Advanced Studies in Ecumenism of the Institute for Ecumenical Studies of the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome (*Angelicum*).
- The Programme offers scholarships to clerics or laypeople from different Christian traditions, who wish to deepen their research in ecumenism.
- Candidates accepted into the programme will relocate to Rome for one academic year (from October 2023 to June 2024).

Scholarship

- The scholarship covers the academic fees for one year. The researcher will also receive a monthly stipend of c. €1,2000 intended to cover full boarding, travel, insurance and other expenses.
- A Certificate will be issued by the University after having completed the research programme.

Academic schedule

- Fellows will be asked to participate in:
 - o A weekly two-hour hours' workshop;
 - The "Ut Unum Sint" ongoing formation programme in ecumenism (8 monthly sessions on Fridays including lectures, workshops and ecumenical visits);
 - o Conferences organized or co-sponsored by the Institute for Ecumenical Studies.
- At the end of the academic year, fellows will discuss the results of their research project, which will be published, if accepted, in the *Analecta Oecumenica* series of the Institute for Ecumenical Studies.
- Fellows will also have the possibility to attend courses offered by the Institute for Ecumenical Studies.

Required documentation

- For admission to the scholarship programme:
 - o Curriculum vitae (including a PhD certificate).
 - o A statement of intent (300 words).
 - o A description of the candidate's scientific project on an ecumenical topic.
- For the admission to the University: ordinary requirements can be reviewed here.
