Rooted in the Catholic principles of ecumenism and the Dominican ecumenical tradition, the Institute for Ecumenical Studies of the Angelicum operates under the auspices of the Dicastery for Promoting Christian Unity (Vatican).

It offers the following degrees: **Diploma** (1 year); **Licentiate** (2 years); **Doctorate** (3 years); and **Post-doctorate** (1 year) in theology with specialization in ecumenical/interreligious studies. Specific programs for sabbaticals are also available. The Institute sponsors international ecumenical academic conferences and public lectures.

The teaching staff includes the best international experts in the field involved in the ecumenical movement and interreligious dialogue.
