315. [DECLARATION] The expression Salamanca Process, "by analogy with the meeting of the preachers of Hispaniola and theologians of Salamanca", refers to research based on the experience of situations where the equal dignity and rights of persons and peoples are not respected or are endangered that "aims to place theology at the service of law and respect for human, individual and social dignity".

316. [EXHORTATION] (...) The Salamanca Process (...) promote dialogue between academic work and the pastoral experience of brothers, especially of those working in places where the rights of individuals and peoples and the integrity of the creation are not respected or are threatened. This dialogue should also be extended to bioethical issues, especially those related to the respect of life.
