

## Bien Hôa (2019)

315. [DECLARATION] The expression Salamanca Process, “by analogy with the meeting of the preachers of Hispaniola and theologians of Salamanca”, refers to **research** based on the experience of situations where the equal dignity and rights of persons and peoples are not respected or are endangered that “aims to place **theology** at the service of law and respect for human, individual and social **dignity**”.

316. [EXHORTATION] (...) The Salamanca Process (...) promote dialogue between **academic** work and the pastoral experience of brothers, especially of those working in places where the rights of individuals and peoples and the integrity of the **creation** are not respected or are threatened. This dialogue should also be extended to **bioethical** issues, especially those related to the respect of **life**.
